Do you remember the tickle in your tummy on a swing? Or maybe you have a child in your life who absolutely loves the local park. There is something so special about hearing children's laughter as they whizz down a slide or spin on a roundabout. Higher! Faster! Again!

I remember my daughter's total lack of fear in the park, which often made me panic. I remember too how my son tentatively climbed the slide for the first time, feeling much less brave than his big sister. He learned from her, following in her footsteps, listening to her encouraging him to keep climbing.

Play is more than fun. It's how children heal, learn, and grow. It builds confidence, sparks creativity, and helps those who need it to recover from trauma. For those who have lost parents and security, play is a lifeline.

Children like Rani age 15, Ramesh age 11 and Rupa, who is just 4 (pictured right). We found these precious children lying on the floor of the shack they knew as home. Alone and traumatised, they had lost their father and then their mother to HIV. All had watched their parents die in front of them without the medical care and pain relief we take for granted.

Orphaned and alone, these children were desperate for help. Perhaps the hardest hit was the eldest sister, having to be the main carer for their mum, and also for her two siblings. Can you imagine how she felt, grieving for her parents and not knowing how she could provide for her little brother and sister?

Thankfully, a compassionate person like you has sponsored these children. They are now recovering and being cared for at Shanti Children's village. But while their physical health has improved, it's going to take much longer to heal their hearts and minds. They need to have the opportunity to just be children, without worry or care.



Sadly, there are many children living at Shanti Nivas who share a similar story. Part of their healing happens through play. It's how they let go of the struggles that have shaped their young lives. They need to learn to laugh again and regain the childhood they deserve.

But right now, the old swings, slides and play equipment at Shanti Nivas are broken and unsafe. Poor quality equipment has rusted and there are very sharp edges. Swings have corroded and are broken.

This Christmas, will you help to build a playground to help restore joy? A bright, safe space where laughter rings out and hope takes root. Quality, fun equipment that is safe and durable. Imagine the joy of children swinging high, sliding down, or holding tight on a roundabout for the first time. That's the miracle you can make happen.
